

My account password has expired - what should I do?

Read the prompts on the screen to successfully change your password. When selecting a new password, keep in mind that your new password must be at least 6 characters in length, and must contain at least one number. Passwords cannot include any part of your first or last name.

DO NOT share your new password with others! Your account contains important and confidential information about your child. It is VERY important for the security of your child's data that you protect your logon information as you would any other personal account.


