ARTICLE

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate, borrow or transfer from available funds, an amount of money to be expended under the direction of the West Elementary School Building Committee for the design and construction of a new Pre-K through Grade Five Elementary School with an approximate square footage of 191,000 square feet located at 58 Beacon Street, Andover, Massachusetts inclusive of abatement and demolition of the existing school structures on said property, new parking lots, multi-purpose fields, and all other costs incidental and related thereto, which school facility shall have an anticipated useful life as an educational facility for the instruction of school children of at least 50 years, and for which the Town may be eligible for a school construction grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (“MSBA”). The Town acknowledges that the MSBA’s grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the Town incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town. Any grant that the Town may receive from the MSBA for the Project shall not exceed the lesser of (1) forty and forty-seven hundreds percent (40.47%) of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (2) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA, provided that any appropriation hereunder shall be subject to and contingent upon an affirmative vote of the Town to exempt the amounts required for the payment of interest and principal on said borrowing from the limitations on taxes imposed by M.G.L. 59, Section 21C (Proposition 2½) and that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the Town of Andover and the MSBA. Or take any other action relative thereto. Sponsored by the School Committee.

BORROWING AUTHORIZATION

That the Town of Andover raise and appropriate the amount of One Hundred Fifty Million (\$ 150,000,000) Dollars for the purpose of paying costs for the construction of a new Pre-K to Five West Elementary School, located at 58 Beacon Street, Andover, Massachusetts, inclusive of abatement and demolition of the existing school structures on said property, new parking lots, multi-purpose fields, and including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto (the “Project”), which school facility shall have an anticipated useful life as an educational facility for the instruction of school children for at least 50 years, and for which the Town of Andover may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (“MSBA”), said amount to be expended under the direction of the West Elementary School Building Committee . To meet this appropriation, the Town Treasurer, is authorized to borrow said amount under M.G.L. Chapter 44, or pursuant to any other enabling authority. The Town of Andover acknowledges that the MSBA’s grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any project costs the Town of Andover incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town of Andover; provided further that any grant that Town of Andover may receive from the MSBA for the Project shall not exceed the lesser of (1) forty and forty-seven hundreds percent (40.47%) of eligible, approved project costs, as determined by the MSBA, or (2) the total maximum grant amount determined by the MSBA; provided that any appropriation hereunder shall be subject to and contingent upon an affirmative vote of the Town to exempt the amounts required for the payment of interest and principal on said borrowing from the limitations on taxes imposed by M.G.L. 59, Section 21C (Proposition 2½); and that the amount of borrowing authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement that may be executed between the Town of Andover and the MSBA.
