State Testing Schedule, Spring 2016

Please mark your calendars! Our third, fourth, and fifth graders will take PARCC Testing in May in both English Language Arts and Mathematics. Additionally, our fifth graders will take the Science, Technology, and Engineering MCAS. Dates are as follows:

Grade 3

Mathematics: Monday and Tuesday, May 2 & 3 and Thursday and Friday, May 5 & 6
English Language Arts: Monday through Wednesday, May 16 – 18.

Grade 4

Mathematics: Monday and Tuesday, May 2 & 3 and Thursday and Friday, May 5 & 6
English Language Arts: Tuesday through Thursday, May 10 – 12

Grade 5

Mathematics: Monday and Tuesday, May 2 & 3 and Thursday and Friday, May 5 & 6
English Language Arts: Tuesday through Thursday, May 10 – 12
Science, Tech, and Engineering: Thursday and Friday, May 19 & 20.

Kindergarten Registration Week: February 8 – 12, 2016

Completed Kindergarten Registrations (all can be found on line), Full Day Kindergarten Applications and deposit checks will be accepted in our school office from **10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M Monday through Friday** with extended hours on

Wednesday, February 10 from 4:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. After Registration Week, please contact us for an appointment to register your child(ren). Notification on the status of Full-day Kindergarten Applications will be sent out the week of March 7, 2016. Over-enrollment in Full Day Kindergarten classes may result in the implementation of a lottery system.

You are encouraged to register your child during registration week. Per School Committee Policy #JCA, if there is over enrollment in a grade level at any of the elementary schools, the elementary school principals will assign any student who registers for kindergarten through Grade 5 on or after June 1 to a school that has not maximized its class size.

100th Day Food Drive

We have had a great response thus far to our Lazarus House 100th Day Food Drive. Our goal is to collect 100 food items per grade on or before the 100th day of school (Wednesday, February 10th). Items being collected by each grade level are:

Kindergarten (Captains Abi Bapanapalli & Anthony Kim): Canned tuna, canned meat, canned vegetables.

Grade 1 (Captains Gabriella Bresnick & Shreya Patel): Jell-O, cake mixes, coffee, juice boxes, powdered drink mixes.

Grade 2 (Captains Randy Tran & Ben Szeto): White rice (1 pound boxes), any “Goya” brand product, soup – canned or dry.

Grade 3 (Captains Sunjae Kim & Marc Llorens): Macaroni and cheese, spaghetti sauce, and canned tomato products.

Grade 4 (Captains Saumya Bawari & Vivienne Foley): Peanut butter, boxed cereal, family size (1 gallon) mustard, mayo and ketchup.

Grade 5 (Captains Saumya Bawari & Vivienne Foley): All types of dry pasta (spaghetti, ziti, etc.), canned pasta (ravioli, spaghetti-o’s, Beef-a-roni, etc.

There are collection bins for each grade level, located within each wing.

Important Safety Reminders

Please remember that supervision on the playground begins at 8:15 A.M. Children may not be dropped off prior to 8:15 A.M. unless they are participating in a before school program!

Please review the information in the PTO section below, for reminders/updates to morning drop off! It is important that all follow these rules to insure a smooth, and more importantly, SAFE, arrival for our children. Thanks to our volunteers, and increased compliance, our drop off is much smoother and safer!

Also, we now have six school buses and two vans departing the front horseshoe between 2:50 – 3:05 P.M. Please remember **state law** prohibits passing a school bus/van with lights flashing! Buses/vans have priority in that front horseshoe in the afternoon. If you are parked in the lot, expect that you *will* have to wait until all buses have departed. **Please follow the law**, which promotes student safety!!

Also, the Andover PD has asked me to remind all that, in the absence of a handicap plate or placard, cars should not be stopped, even briefly, in a designated handicap space. We do have staff members and volunteers who legitimately need to access those spaces.
