

Plan for APS Students In Quarantine 2021-2022



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- APS guidelines for student quarantine align with what the district's educators have consistently provided for our students who have been absent due to illness or injury.
- APS staff members will be used to support student learning while the student is in quarantine.
- Each school has created a support team to address academic support for students on quarantine.
- Staff members may include: the student's teacher, instructional assistants, reading specialists, math coaches, and digital learning coaches.
- Touch point staff person and Google Meet specifics will be identified by school-based leaders.

Grades PK-2 Students / Families Who Are Quarantined Will Receive:

- Take home packets
- A minimum of two touch points with APS staff member daily
- Touch points with students via Google Meet
- Contact from APS staff member to families to establish expectations to meet
- Assignments and materials by APS

Grades 6-8 Students Who Are Quarantined Will Have:

- Assignments provided in Schoology by APS staff
- Contact from APS staff member with students using Google Meet to establish opportunities to meet for assistance with learning tasks and/or instruction
- Google Meet will take place during 30-minute after school time starting at 2:50PM

Grades 9-12 Students Who Are Quarantined Will Have:

- We continue to monitor additional supports that may be provided to students in quarantine.
- Assignments provided in Schoology by APS staff.
- Google Meet contact from an APS staff member with students to establish expectations and opportunities to meet.
- An APS staff member to assist students during H-Block or Transitions.
- Opportunities to meet with APS staff using Google Meet facetime to address their needs.
