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- District/Charter Schools are reviewed every 3 years by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) through the Tiered Focused Monitoring system.

# Tiered Focused Monitoring System

*DESE places districts in groups based on the monitoring cycle.*

- Group A focuses primarily on special education standards with less focus on civil rights.
- Group B is what would be considered the mid-cycle review with the primary focus on civil rights.

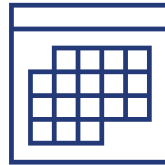
